Apologies for this delayed reply.

HFAC discussed your latest response at our meeting on May 19, 2026. Board members were pleased that we had been able to meet with you and your team several times, and that you were willing to listen to our concerns and ideas.

At the same time, HFAC is disappointed that these meetings did not lead to more concrete progress. Because both HFAC and Massport are bodies with a statutory role to play in terms of airport oversight and community governance, our hope had been that Massport would collaborate with us in exploring and developing solutions to shared concerns.

We are pleased that to know that Massport remains committed to safety and security at all its facilities, including Hanscom Field, as well as to being a good community partner with its neighbors. Since we do have current community concerns, as well as safety concerns, regarding ICE flights at Hanscom, we hope to see Massport take responsibility, in its role as airport manager, to implement a concrete course of action to address these concerns.

Thank you again for your time and willingness to consider these ideas.
