Meeting started at 1:08 pm

1. It was decided to defer review of the meeting minutes from last 2 meetings until the next EAC meeting.
2. The activity room in the Abbott Library has been reserved for an information session on the solar ordinance and solar bond warrant articles on March 3 from 4:30 to 5:45 pm.
3. Catherine received an email questioning whether the proposed solar ordinance would protect potential impacts to the ridgeline
4. Allyson Traeger said that the Planning Board would start looking at more detailed regulations for commercial properties for future additions to the ordinance. Public hearings with abutter notifications already addresses steep slopes through steep slope ordinance.
5. Doug Cogan asked about commercial system net-metering into grid – How will it be decided what would constitute primary to secondary use? The answer to this question was that it will get teased out in site plan review.
6. It was decided to add a sentence to the solar ordinance information pamphlet pointing out how the site review process would be used for commercial solar projects.
7. It was decided that it would be good to hold a second informational meeting at LSPA.
8. Doug Cogan thinks that receiving the ITC/Direct Pay benefit is more certain than the pamphlet indicates.
9. Dates and venues for holding public information sessions were discussed.
